SCARLET MACAW PLATE



MATERIALS

DB37467 - Squrve Dinner Plate
#6 Round Brush
#2 Round Brush
#1 Short Liner Brush
Tissue Paper
Water-Based Marker
Pencil

COLORS

CMM90 - Red Hot

CMM46 - Sunny Side Up

CMM29 - Grasshopper

CMM43 - Saffire

CMM13 - Cinnamon Stick

CMM31 - Licorice

CMM67 - Snow Flake



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wipe a damp sponge over the entire plate to remove dust and contaminants.
- 2. Trace the design from the pattern sheet onto the tissue paper with a pencil.
- 3. Place the tissue paper pattern on the pottery and trace over the lines with a water-based marker to transfer the lines.
- 4. Paint 3 coats of Red Hot on the top of the head, body, top of the wing, and the tail.
- 5. Paint the rest of the wing with 3 coats of the following color pattern from top to bottom: Sunny Side Up, Grasshopper, and Saffire.
- 6. Paint 3 coats of Licorice on the eye and bottom of the face.
- 7. Paint 3 coats of Cinnamon Stick on the branch.
- 8. Paint 3 coats of Licorice on the talons.
- 9. With a liner brush, carefully outline the design with Licorice.
- 10. With Snow Flake, add small eye shine dots with the back of a paint brush.
- 11. Using the back of the pencil like a stamp, make Licorice dots around the edge of the plate as a border.

TIPS

- Allow paint to dry between coats.
- Wash brush between colors.
- Use a contrasted colored marker to make the pattern more visible as you are painting.
- Use masking tape to hold the tissue paper while you are tracing if it shifts.
- To get thinner lines when you are outlining shapes with your liner brush, press down lightly. The harder you push on the brush, the thicker your lines will be.
- Periodically rinse your liner brush to remove color build-up to keep your lines a consistent size.
